Porn sites receive more regular traffic than Netflix, Amazon & Twitter combined each month...

The annual productivity loss to companies from employees looking at pornography at work is a staggering \$16.9 Billion dollars.

# **EVERY DAY:**

37 pornographic videos are created in the United States.

2.5 billion emails containing porn are sent or received.

68 million search queries related to pornography — 25% of total searches — are generated.

116,000 queries related to child pornography are received.

Porn is a global, estimated **\$97 billion industry,** with about <u>\$12 billion</u> of that coming from the United States.

Pornography use increases the marital infidelity rate by more than 300%.

# Is it really a **big deal**?

## **Choosing Trust**

Choosing to tell someone what is going on is risky. It's choosing to trust, to take a risk, without certainty of what will happen next. God says if we want to be forgiven, we should tell him (1 John 1:9), but if we want to be healed, we should tell someone else (James 5:13-18).

When a guy takes the risk to open up, the last thing he needs is condemnation. Faced with sin, we are tempted with three responses: hurt, shame, or apathy. We were not designed to absorb sin, so we either try to carry it, transfer it, or reject it. Our inadequacy become clear and we run away.

Instead of the place where people came expecting shame, what if people came to this group knowing they would receive grace? What if we became the type of group where someone could take off their mask and we could help them see who they really are? Instead of pointing people back to their mistakes, what if we pointed them to Jesus? The focus of this week is about trust, about choosing to trust the guys around us, and being trustworthy with what we've been told.

# **SESSION 4**

## Stay in Step

Faced with problems he probably had answers to, Jesus rarely doled out advice. He asked many more questions than he gave answers. He said more about trust than he did about sure-fire guarantees.

To all my fellow fixers: instead of fixing, try listening. Yes, there's a time for practical help. Here's what's needed most: help us return our focused attention to Jesus. He told us the secret sauce is to stay close to him through his Spirit. This isn't natural for us. We much prefer giving advice to listening, and we are usually more comfortable with formulas than faith.

In this session, we'll talk about the Holy Spirit. It might feel like a right-hand turn. When Paul went to describe how to get rid of the sin and stuff that messes up the world, he didn't lay out antidotes and programs. He pointed us back to God. Talking about God's leading through his Spirit might feel uncomfortable. Sometimes Christians can get a bit wonky about the Holy Spirit. Rest assured, the New Testament teaches that an encounter with the Holy Spirit is exactly like an encounter with Jesus.

You may remember from Session 3 that God's plan for us to regain integrity is to confess to one another. We maintain integrity by staying in step with what God is doing and responding to how he is leading. Read the passages on page 16 and think about how you can encourage one another to listen and respond to God.
