- 1- Plastic Recloseable Bag (1 Gallon)
- 1- Hand Towel
- 1- Bar of Soap (Plastic sealed or in a box)
- 1- Toothbrush (In original packaging)
- 1- Toothpaste- 6 oz/ Regular tube. Please secure with tape.
- 1- Shampoo- Up to 3 oz. Please secure lid with tape.
- 1- Comb
- 1- Regular Size Stick Deodorant (No powders or aerosols)
