## INSTRUCTIONS

**STEP 2:** Select one or more items from the list below, and decide how you will collect or purchase them. Focus on getting new items. You may invite neighbors and co-workers to donate as well.

**STEP 3:** Gather your donations. Spend some time praying for FCSF clients who will benefit from them.

**STEP 4:** Donations can be delivered Tuesday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or shipped to FCSF (see address below).

Boys khaki pants (size 2T through 10), boys socks (all sizes), girls socks (all sizes), winter pajamas for girls and boys (all sizes), boys jeans (size 5 to 18), boys long sleeve shirts (size 12 to 18), and hair items (headbands, barrettes, clips, elastics)
