Discussion Questions

1. Name one of your all-time favorite movies or TV series. What makes it a great story?
2. When you hear the phrase "The Story of God," does your mind go to the past, present, or future? Why do you think this is so?
3. How can trying to be a part of God's daily plan help us understand the big picture of God's plan?
4. Read Habakkuk 3:2 out loud. Discuss with your group. What stands out to you?
5. The prophet Habakkuk records a series of questions for God, along with God's responses. Even though he didn't fully understand God's ways, look how Habakkuk starts one of his prayers to God. **Read Habakkuk 3:2.** What stands out to you?
6. **Read Luke 5:23–24.** Given that passage, how would you respond to someone who asked if God is still performing miracles today?
7. When we get beyond thinking that church is a building and a place to go, it shifts our understanding. What do you think God's plan is for the global church? How do you think *our* church fits into that plan?
8. Is it difficult or easy for you to believe you are part of God's plan? Why or why not?
