Discussion Questions

- 2. **Read 1 Corinthians 12:12–27**. Paul told followers of Jesus that they were the representatives of Jesus here on earth and that *every one* of them had a role to play. How does this picture of what Jesus' body *should* look like relate to how you've viewed or experienced church?
- 3. Paul knew we would be tempted to question our abilities, compare ourselves to others, or wonder if we were even needed (1 Corinthians 12:15–18). Have you ever felt one of these tensions as it relates to the idea of serving in the church?
- 4. How does it impact you to know that you are a *needed* part of Jesus' body here on earth and that God has *placed* the parts of his body just as he wanted them to be?
- 5. Hundreds of people have found their part to play here at Buckhead Church. If you are currently serving, share where you serve, how you got involved, and why you serve. If you aren't currently serving, what's holding you back? How can this group help you find a way to serve at Buckhead Church?
