Discussion Questions

2. Read Colossians 4:2–4. In these verses, what does Paul list as a priority in life? Where is Paul when he writes this? Would you have other priorities if you were in his situation?
3. Read Colossians 4:4–6. What does it mean to have conversations *full of grace* and *seasoned with salt*? Is there anything you need to adjust so that evangelism is more natural in your life?
4. Do you agree with the following statement: “The purpose of your life is bigger than your life”? Why or why not?
5. Where are you loving, serving, and pointing others to God? Based on your answer, what is a next step you need to take this week?
